I am not sure what is in the works regarding those, but we on the south side of the hamlet would love to get a speed sign similar to the one on Rt. 22 as you come into town from the west. There is a 30 mile an hour sign just south of our property which 90% of the cars coming into town ignore. Speeding is a real problem and I think a "your speed is" sign could help.

Just watched the board meeting and I want to clarify a couple things. In 2016 was the PM on pumps, this is where the tech. Pulls the pumps out of the lift stations. A total of 3 lift stations with 2 pumps in each station, 6 pumps. Last year 2019, the invoice was for 1 pump that had to be pulled from lift station and be brought back to vendors to be worked on. So this (2020) contract is for 4 lift stations, 1 is at plant, total of 8 pumps for PM. Hope his helps.
