## ESSEX COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

*WHEREAS*, the *Town of Essex* in Essex County, New York is most vulnerable to natural and humanmade hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

*WHEREAS*, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

*WHEREAS*, the *Town of Essex* acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

*WHEREAS*, the Essex County 2019 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Essex County Emergency Management Agency and in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the *Town of Essex* and

*WHEREAS*, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Essex County 2019 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

*WHEREAS*, the Essex County 2019 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-made hazards that face the County and its municipal governments,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body for the Town of Essex:

• The Essex County 2019 Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the *Town of Essex*, and
